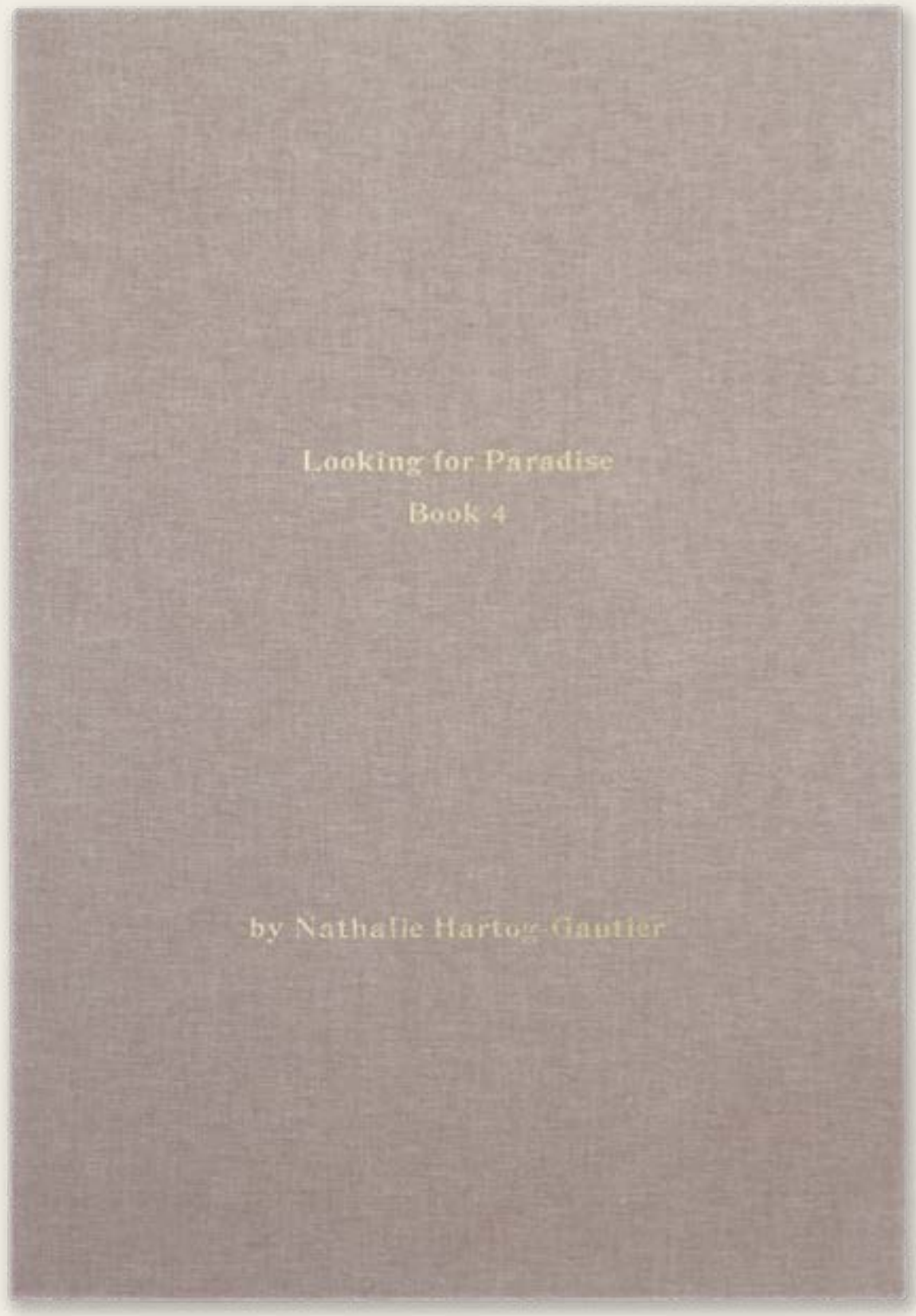

Although exact figures are not available, it is believed that 515 prisoners of war were released from Vietnam in 1975. This number is believed to include about 140 Vietnamese.

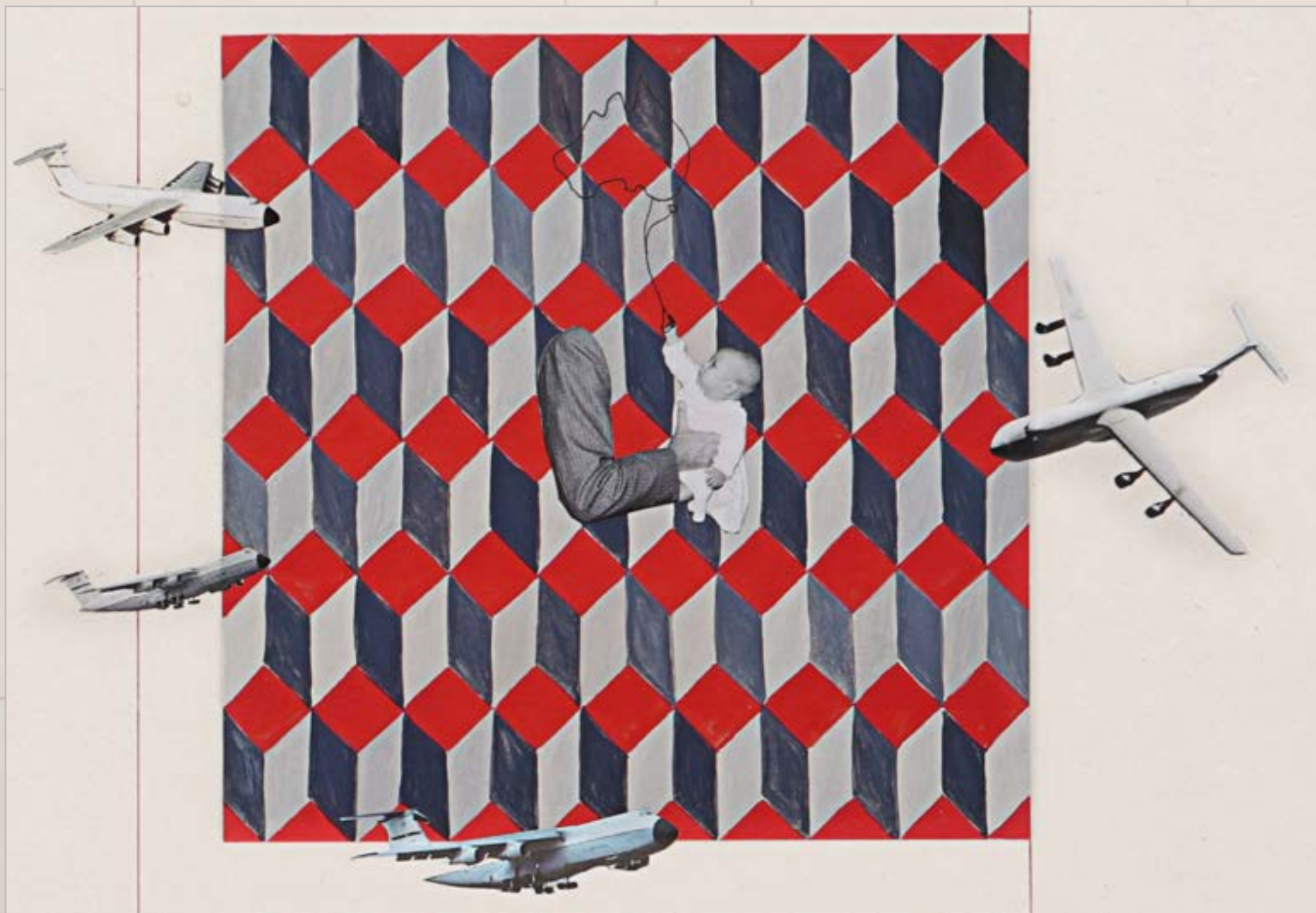
